

Fitness Rewards Program Frequently Asked Questions

Updated January 2020

Q: What is the OhioHealth Fitness Rewards Program?

A: Exercise is an important part of a healthy lifestyle. The OhioHealth Fitness Rewards Program is a great way for you to stay fit and healthy. Associates enrolled in one of the OhioHealthy medical plans or Opt-in to Wellness can earn back up to 100 percent of their membership dues, depending on how many times the associate visits the respective facility. Q. Who is eligible for the Fitness Rewards Program?

A: All OhioHealth associates that participate in the OhioHealth Medical Plan, or Opt-in to Wellness, are eligible for the Fitness Rewards Program.

Q: How does the program work?

A: Associates must elect to pay for their membership via payroll deduction. Any enrollment fees are not reimbursable through the Fitness Rewards Program.

The reimbursement eligibility is based on quarterly participation/visits. At the end of each quarter, the total number of visits will be reviewed and reimbursed as follows:

- 24 or more visits per quarter (about two times per week) = 100 percent membership fees reimbursement (less taxes)
- 18-23 visits per quarter = 50 percent membership fees reimbursement (less taxes)
- Less than 18 visits per quarter = 0 percent membership fees reimbursement

Q: Is the reimbursement a taxable benefit?

A: Reimbursement of your gym membership fees is subject to tax withholding. This is because the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) considers these payments to be part of your income from OhioHealth.



Q: How is a quarter defined and how long after the quarter ends will I receive my reimbursement?

A: Quarters are aligned with a pay period calendar to ensure accurate and coordinated reimbursement. Associates will receive their reimbursement the month following the end of a respective quarter. Associates must be employed and enrolled in one of the OhioHealthy medical plans at the end of a defined quarter and must be employed at the time of payout to receive reimbursement.

Q: Can my family members join the Fitness Rewards Program?

A: Your spouse and child(ren) are eligible to join if they are covered under one of the OhioHealthy medical plans as your dependent.

Q: I am not enrolled in one of the OhioHealthy medical plans or an Opt-in to Wellness participant. Are there any discount options for me?

A: The McConnell Heart Health Center, Grant Health & Fitness Center, Ontario Health & Fitness Center, and Wellness & Prevention Center offer discounts to all OhioHealth associates. Other fitness facilities around the Central Ohio area offer discounts to OhioHealth associates through our <u>Perks</u> <u>Place</u>.

Q: Can I join and be reimbursed for membership at an OhioHealth facility and the YMCA?

A: You can only be reimbursed for one membership option with one payroll deduction. If you choose to be a member of both an OhioHealth-owned facility and the YMCA, facility visits will not be combined toward the incentive goal.

Q: As a member of the Fitness Rewards Program can I use other OhioHealth fitness centers?

A: If you are a member of an OhioHealth fitness center, you will automatically have access to the Blom Administrative Campus fitness center at no additional cost. Your visits at both centers can be used towards your Fitness Rewards reimbursement.

McConnell Heart Health Center

Q: How do I get started?

Q: What are the hours of operation?

A: MHHC Facility Hours of Operation: <u>Monday – Friday</u>: 5:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. <u>Saturday</u>: 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. <u>Sunday</u>: 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

Q: What is the cost of membership?

A: Enrollment fees for membership for an OhioHealth associate is \$99.00. OhioHealth associate dues via payroll deduction are \$27.79 per pay period. For additional information on extended family rates, please contact the McConnell Heart Health Center at (614) 566.5356.

Grant Health and Fitness Center

Q: How do I get started?

A: Learn more about the Grant Health and Fitness Center at <u>www.ohiohealth.com/grantfitnesscenter/</u> or by calling (614) 566.9880. Associates are also encouraged to tour the facility, located at 340 E. Town Street, 9th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215. Tour appointments can be scheduled ahead of time via phone.

Q: What are the hours of operation?

A: Monday – Friday: 5:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. Saturday – Sunday: 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Q: What is the cost of membership?

A: The enrollment fees for an OhioHealth associate is \$43.00. Primary OhioHealth associate dues via payroll deduction are \$17.20 per pay period.

Blom Administrative Campus Fitness Center

Q: How do I get started in the program?

A: Registration forms are required prior to gaining access to the Fitness Center. Stop by the Fitness Center to learn more. All members are required to complete a health history questionnaire and waiver before receiving a membership card. The initial paperwork for registration is available on eSource. Search Blom Administrative Campus from the home page and click the Fitness Center tab on the right. You can email completed registration forms to <u>AdminCampusFitnessCenter@ohiohealth.com</u> or bring them to the fitness center once the Center has opened.

Q: What are the hours of operation?

A: Monday-Thursday: 5:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Friday: 5:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday and Sunday: Closed

Q: What is the cost of membership?

A: Membership is \$15 per month (\$6.92 per pay period). Payroll deduction is required.

Q: Is there a dual membership option with another OhioHealth fitness center?

A: OhioHealth associates that are members at any OhioHealth Fitness Center will receive free access to the Blom Administrative Campus Fitness Center. Visits at all OhioHealth fitness center will count towards your Fitness Rewards reimbursement.



Q. How do I cancel my membership?

A: Blom Administrative Campus Fitness Center members may cancel their membership at any time without penalty. Request of cancellation must be received on or before the 20th of the month in order to cancel membership for the following month. Monthly fees will not be prorated, and refunds will not be provided.

Wellness & Prevention Center and the Ontario Health & Fitness Center (Mansfield):

Q: How do I get started in the program?

A: Current Wellness & Prevention Center (WPC) or Ontario Health & Fitness Center (OHFC) members and non-members that meet the eligibility criteria (see above) will need to sign a new **membership contract**, sign the **Fitness Rewards Program Contract**, and fill out the **payroll deduction form**.

Q: What are the hours of the Wellness & Prevention Center and the Ontario Health & Fitness Center?

A: WPC Hours of Operation:

Monday – Thursday: 5:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Friday: 5:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Saturday: 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Sunday: CLOSED

OHFC Hours of Operation:

Monday – Thursday: 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Friday: 5:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Saturday: 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Sunday: 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Q: What is the cost of membership (includes both facilities)?

A: Initial enrollment fees are waived for associates. If an associate cancels and rejoins the facility, a \$60 enrollment fee will be charged. Primary OhioHealth associate dues via payroll deduction are \$18.22 per pay period. Please contact either center for additional membership information.

Hardin Wellness Center

Q. How do I get started in the program?

A. Current members: Please see Aaron Burkett to revise your current membership.



New memberships: Associates will need to schedule an appointment to sign up to review eligibility, sign Fitness Rewards Program contract, payroll deduction form, and screening paperwork. An appointment can be scheduled by calling 419-675-8111. The appointment will take approximately 15 minutes.

Q. What are the costs associated with the Wellness Center?

A. Membership is \$11.54 per pay. There is no enrollment fee.

Q. What are the hours of operation at the Hardin Wellness Center?

A. Hardin Wellness Center hours of operation Monday –Thursday: 5:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
Friday: 5:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Saturday: 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

WellWorks at Ohio University

Q: How do I get started in the program?

A: Learn more about WellWorks at <u>https://www.ohio.edu/wellworks</u> or by calling 740.593.2093. Associates are also encouraged to tour our facility, located on the first floor of Grover Center, Ohio University's Athens campus, any time during our hours of operation. Associates must present their employee badge to the front desk staff when signing up for membership.

Q: What is the cost of the membership?

A: OhioHealth associate dues via payroll deduction are \$10.00 per pay period. If you would like to upgrade to a family membership, you must pay \$90 to WellWorks and this will not be reimbursed from OhioHealth. (*WellWorks annual family memberships includes 2 adults {parents/guardians} and dependents ages 13-18.*)

Q: Is there an enrollment fee?

A: There is no enrollment fee.

Q: What are the hours of operation at WellWorks?

A: Monday – Thursday, 5:45 a.m - 9:00 p.m. Friday 5:45 am - 8:00 pm Saturday - Sunday 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

<u>YMCA</u>

Q: How do I get started in the program?

A: <u>YMCA Non-Members</u>: If you are currently not a YMCA member and are eligible for the OhioHealth Fitness Rewards Program, visit <u>ymcacolumbus.org/join/ohiohealth</u> to join the YMCA and enroll as an OhioHealth Fitness Rewards Program member.

<u>Current YMCA Members</u>: If you are currently a YMCA member and meet the OhioHealth Fitness Rewards Program eligibility, you can enroll in the OhioHealth Fitness Rewards Program by visiting <u>ymcacolumbus.org/join/ohiohealth</u> and select "Change Membership Type. (Use Google Chrome when accessing this site.) You are able to make this update if your YMCA membership has been active for



more than 30 days. You should allow time for processing. Any changes made within 2 weeks of your next monthly payment will be made the following month.

Please note: Current YMCA members that have not paid their first month dues will be charged the enrollment fee.

Q: What are the costs associated with the YMCA Fitness Rewards Program?

A: At time of registration, an enrollment fee of \$69 is required for new YMCA members. The adult membership is \$18 per pay and household membership is \$32 per pay. The household membership includes one or two adults and their children through the age of 24, who share the same residence. The membership dues eligible for reimbursement reflect those for the OhioHealth associate member only (\$18 per pay period). If both adults on the membership are eligible for the Fitness Rewards program and both achieve the required check-ins, the reimbursement will be based on the household rate.

The YMCA enrollment fee is not included in the subsidy program. For details about additional program and service offerings at each facility, you can contact your local YMCA directly. To participate in Fitness Rewards, associates must elect to pay for their membership via payroll deduction.

Q: With a YMCA membership, am I able to visit any participating Ohio YMCA location and have the visit count towards Fitness Rewards participation requirement?

A: Yes, with your YMCA membership, you are eligible to visit any Ohio YMCA location on the list below.
